Raymond Clarke graduated from Westbrook High School in 1934. He served our country as a pilot in both the Navy and the Air Force. He had a Masters degree in nuclear physics from Ohio State and after retiring from the Air Force he received a degree in education, equipping him to teach High School Math and Science, which he did for several years.

Raymond was a generous man who had a heart for many things, one of which was to help people reach their greatest potential through education.

The purpose of the "Raymond Clarke Scholarship Fund" is to provide financial assistance to students and young adults attending vocational schools, colleges, and universities. Any student who graduates from a high school within a 50-mile radius of Westbrook, Minnesota is eligible to apply.

A student may pursue any academic area of study, however, preference may be given to those pursuing a degree in the natural sciences, including, but not limited to, biology, chemistry, physics, engineering, architecture, or a field related to computer design, theory, applications, or use and also to any course of study which may lead to a career in any field associated with veterinary medicine or animal health science.
